12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - State Government

15 2-1503.1.

16 (A) A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY INTRODUCE UP TO AND17 INCLUDING NINE BILLS DURING A REGULAR OR SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

(B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO BILLS INTRODUCED ON BEHALF OF A
LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY, AN EXECUTIVE
DEPARTMENT OR OTHER UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, OR THE OFFICE OF THE
GOVERNOR.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 1996.
