A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Automotive Dismantlers, Recyclers, and Scrap Processors - Restriction**
3 **Regarding Interstate Travel**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring an automotive dismantler and recycler or scrap processor
5 who operates a vehicle with a special recycler registration plate out of this State to
6 operate the vehicle solely for the business purposes of automotive dismantling and
7 recycling or scrap processing; making a technical correction; and generally relating
8 to the interstate operation of a vehicle with a special recycler registration plate.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Transportation**

18 (a) If an automotive dismantler and recycler or scrap processor licensed under
19 Title 15 of this article owns a vehicle that is mainly used in his business and that otherwise
20 is required to be registered under this title, he may apply to the Administration for the
21 issuance of as many special, recycler registration plates as the Administration authorizes.

22 (b) A licensed automotive dismantler [or] AND recycler or scrap processor may
23 drive, under any one recycler registration plate issued to him:

24 (1) Any used vehicle owned by him and mainly used in his business; and

25 (2) Any vehicle in his possession, but not owned by him, if he has the
26 consent of the owner of the vehicle to this use.

27 (C) WHEN OPERATING A VEHICLE WITH SPECIAL RECYCLER REGISTRATION
28 PLATES OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE, A LICENSED AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND
29 RECYCLER OR SCRAP PROCESSOR SHALL OPERATE THE VEHICLE EXCLUSIVELY FOR
