A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Employment of Minors)**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the minimum age over which an alcoholic beverages licensee
5 in Frederick County may employ a person to perform certain tasks; and generally
6 relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 12-302.

16 (b) In the following jurisdictions the specified exceptions to subsection (a) of this
17 section apply:

18 (7) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, in Frederick
19 County a licensee may employ a person 18 years of age or older to sell, serve, deliver, or
20 otherwise deal with alcoholic beverages and may employ a person [16] 14 years of age or
21 older to perform any other task other than to sell, serve, or deliver alcoholic beverages.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 1996.
