3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Cosmetologists in accordance with the
4 Maryland Program Evaluation Act by extending to a certain date the termination
5 provision relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board and the
6 regulation of cosmetologists; requiring an evaluation to be made of the Board and
7 the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board on or before a certain date; and
8 generally relating to the continuation of the State Board of Cosmetologists.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

4 5-702.

5 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program
6 Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and
7 be of no effect after [July 1, 1996] JULY 1, 2001.

8 **Article - State Government**

9 8-403.

10 (e) On or before November 30 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a
11 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee may waive as unnecessary
12 the evaluation required under this section.

13 (L) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION,
14 ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, ~~2004~~ 2000 AN EVALUATION SHALL BE MADE OF THE STATE
15 BOARD OF COSMETOLOGISTS AND THE REGULATIONS THAT RELATE TO THE STATE
16 BOARD OF COSMETOLOGISTS.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
