- 17 (a) (1) There are State residential centers for individuals with mental
- 18 retardation in the Developmental Disabilities Administration.
- 19 (2) AT LEAST ONE OF THE STATE RESIDENTIAL CENTERS THAT SERVE
- 20 THE NEEDS OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SHALL BE
- 21 LOCATED IN THE SOUTHERN MARYLAND REGION, CONSISTING OF ANNE ARUNDEL,
- 22 CALVERT, CHARLES, AND ST. MARY'S COUNTIES, OR IN THE WASHINGTON
- 23 SUBURBAN REGION, CONSISTING OF MONTGOMERY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S
- 24 COUNTIES.
- 25 (3) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET STATE
- 26 GENERAL FUNDS SUFFICIENT TO COVER THE COST OF OPERATING A STATE
