- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland Aviation Administration to adopt certain
- regulations governing the conduct of commercial activity at State-owned airports; 5
- authorizing the Administration to adopt by regulation a schedule of fines for 6
- 7 commercial activity that violates the regulations; authorizing the Administration to
- 8 impose a fine from the schedule of fines on a person violating the regulations;

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 24
- 25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 20	(c) (1) In this subsection "commercial activity" means the sale, merchandising, marketing, or promotion of [any] goods or services.
	(2) Commercial activity is permitted at an airport operated by the Administration only when expressly authorized by and in a manner prescribed by the Administration.
	(3) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY IMPOSE A FINE AS PROVIDED IN THE SCHEDULE OF FINES ADOPTED UNDER § 5-204(D)(2) OF THIS TITLE ON A PERSON CONDUCTING COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY IN VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION.

	(a) [After] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AFTER holdinga public hearing, the governing body of [any] A publicly owned airport in his State may adopt regulations for:
	(1) The parking of motor vehicles at the airport, including provision of a uniform system for accessible parking for individuals with disabilities to enhance the safety of people with disabilities in conformity with:

  5 BY REGULATION A SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF PARKING
  6 REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION AT A
  7 STATE-OWNED AIRPORT.

- 11 (a) [Any] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A 12 person who violates a parking regulation adopted and posted under § 5-426 of this
- 13 subtitle is subject to a fine not exceeding \$50. [A violation of a parking regulation is not 14 a misdemeanor.]
- 15 (b) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES A PARKING REGULATION ADOPTED AND
   16 POSTED UNDER § 5-426 OF THIS SUBTITLE AT A STATE-OWNED AIRPORT IS SUBJECT
   17 TO A FINE AS PROVIDED IN THE SCHEDULE OF FINES ADOPTED BY THE
- 18 ADMINISTRATION UNDER § 5-426(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 19 (C) A VIOLATION OF A PARKING REGULATION IS NOT A MISDEMEANOR.
- 20 (D) [Any] A person who violates [any other] ANOTHER rule or regulation
- 21 adopted and posted under § 5-426 of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on
- 22 conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 1996.
