FOR the purpose of specifying, in Anne Arundel County, the annual alcoholic beverages
license renewal date and procedures and penalties that ensue if a renewal is late; altering special license fees; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
9 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
(b) (2) In Anne Arundel County the fee is $[\$ 10] \$ 20$ per day.
(d) (2) In Anne Arundel County:
(i) A special beer, wine and liquor license, Class C licensee may

25 purchase beer from a wholesaler.

(Q) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

(2) BETWEEN MARCH 1 AND MARCH 31, INCLUSIVE, EACH YEAR, A

(II) A LATE CHARGE OF $\$ 250$, PLUS A DAY CHARGE OF $\$ 50$ FOR 9 EACH DAY THE APPLICATION IS FILED LATE. THE TOTAL AMOUNT MAY NOT 10 EXCEED \$1,500.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 1996.
