4 FOR the purpose of specifying, in Anne Arundel County, the annual alcoholic beverages
5 license renewal date and procedures and penalties that ensue if a renewal is late;
6 altering special license fees; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne
7 Arundel County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

22 (b) (2) In Anne Arundel County the fee is [\$10] \$20 per day.

1 (d) (2) In Anne Arundel County:

2 (i) A special beer, wine and liquor license, Class C licensee may
3 purchase beer from a wholesaler.

4 (ii) The fee is [~~\$25~~] \$50 per day.

6 (Q) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

7 (2) BETWEEN MARCH 1 AND MARCH 31, INCLUSIVE, EACH YEAR, A
8 LICENSEE SHALL FILE AN APPLICATION FOR LICENSE RENEWAL WITH THE BOARD.

9 (3) A LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION RECEIVED BY THE BOARD
10 AFTER MARCH 31 MAY BE SUBJECT TO:

11 (I) REJECTION; OR

12 (II) A LATE CHARGE OF \$250, PLUS A ~~DAY~~ CHARGE OF \$50 FOR
13 EACH DAY THE APPLICATION IS FILED LATE.

14 (4) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF LATE CHARGES MAY NOT EXCEED \$1,500.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 1996.
