- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) [On] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, ON
- 19 redemption, the plaintiff or the holder of a certificate of sale is entitled to be reimbursed
- 20 for expenses incurred in any action or in preparation for any action toforeclose the right
- 21 of redemption. In addition, the plaintiff or holder of a certificate ofsale, on redemption,
- 22 is entitled to be reimbursed for fees paid for recording the certificate of sale, for
- 23 attorney's fees in the sum of \$400 for each certificate of sale, for expenses incurred in the
