- 15 (A) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a person shall belicensed by the
- 16 Department before the person may operate a residential service agency.
- 17 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT REQUIRE A BRANCH OF A LICENSED
- 18 RESIDENTIAL SERVICE AGENCY TO PAY A SEPARATE LICENSE FEE UNDER THIS
