3 F	OR the purpose of altering certain fees charged by the State Board of Architects, the
4	State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects, the State Board for Professional
5	Engineers, and the State Board for Professional Land Surveyors for licensees to
6	reinstate licenses; requiring certain licensees to pay certain renewal fees; requiring
7	the State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects to reinstate certain licenses
8	under certain circumstances; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating
9	to the fees charged by the State Board of Architects, the State Board of Examiners
10	of Landscape Architects, the State Board for Professional Engineers, and the State
11	Board for Professional Land Surveyors for licensees to reinstate licenses.

- 26 (A) The Board shall reinstate the license of an architect who, for any reason, has
- 27 failed to renew the license by the end of the 30-day grace period if the architect:
- 28 (1) meets the renewal requirements of § 3-309 of this subtitle;
- 29 (2) pays to the Board [the] ALL PAST DUE renewal [fee required under § 30 3-309 of this subtitle] FEES;

	(3) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, pays to the Board a reinstatement fee [not exceeding \$85, as set by the Board] OF \$100, IN ADDITION TO ALL PAST DUE RENEWAL FEES; and
