- 3 FOR the purpose of altering certain fees charged by the State Board of Architects, the
 4 State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects, the State Board for Professional
 5 Engineers, and the State Board for Professional Land Surveyors for licensees to
 6 reinstate licenses; requiring certain licensees to pay certain renewal fees; requiring
 7 the State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects to reinstate certain licenses
 8 under certain circumstances; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating
 9 to the fees charged by the State Board of Architects, the State Board of Examiners
- of Landscape Architects, the State Board for Professional Engineers, and the State
 Board for Professional Land Surveyors for licensees to reinstate licenses.
