4 FOR the purpose of deleting Worcester County from those jurisdictions in which sales of
5 beer to retail alcoholic beverages licensees must be in cash on delivery; and
6 generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Worcester County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 12-112.

16 (a) This section applies only in the following jurisdictions:

17 (1) Baltimore City;

18 (2) Caroline;

19 (3) Cecil;

20 (4) Charles;

21 (5) Harford;

2 (7) Queen Anne's;

4 (9) Somerset;

7 (12) Worcester].

8 (b) A manufacturer or wholesaler may not sell any beer to any retaildealer except
9 for cash on delivery.

10 (c) A suit or action ex contractu to enforce or collect any claim for credit
11 extended in violation of this section may not be maintained in this State.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 1996.
