18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
20	Article - Transportation
21	17-106.
22	(a) If the required security for any vehicle terminates or otherwiselapses at any
23	time, the registration of that vehicle:
24	(1) Is suspended automatically as of the date of termination orlapse; and
25	(2) Remains suspended until:
26	(i) The required security is replaced and the vehicle owner submits
	evidence of replaced security on a form as prescribed by the Administration and certified
	by an insurer or agent; and
20	by an insurer of agent, and

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1 (ii) Any uninsured motorist penalty fee assessed is paid to the 2 Administration.

3 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, eachinsurer or
4 other provider of required security immediately shall notify the Administration of those
5 terminations or other lapses that are final.

6 (2) Each insurer or other provider of required security for a vehicle 7 registered as a Class B (for hire) vehicle under Title 13 of this article shall notify the 8 Administration within 45 days of a termination or other lapse that is final and occurs 9 anytime after the required security is issued or provided.

10 (c) On receipt of a notice under subsection (b) of this section, theAdministration 11 shall make a reasonable effort to notify the owner of the vehicle that his registration has 12 been suspended.

(d) (1) Within 48 hours after an owner is notified by the Administration of thesuspension of registration, the owner shall surrender all evidences of that registration tothe Administration.

16 (2) If the owner fails to surrender the evidences of registration within the17 48-hour period, the Administration:

(i) Shall attempt to recover from the owner the evidences of19 registration; and

20 (ii) May suspend his license to drive until he returns to the Motor 21 Vehicle Administration the evidences of registration.

(3) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH
PRIVATE PARTIES TO PROCURE THE SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT AGENTS TO ASSIST
IN THE RECOVERY OF THE EVIDENCES OF REGISTRATION AS AUTHORIZED IN
PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 October 1, 1996.

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
