1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages - Out-of-State Licensees**

3 FOR the purpose of making statewide the prohibition on certain classes of alcoholic
4 beverages licensees being issued to other entities that hold an alcoholic beverages
5 license in another state or Washington, D.C.; and generally relating to the issuance
6 of alcoholic beverages licenses.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 9-102.

16 (b-3) [(1)] A Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor
17 license may not be issued except by way of renewal [in Baltimore City] to a person,
18 corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage license in any
19 other state OR WASHINGTON, D.C .

20 [(2)] A Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor
21 license may not be issued except by way of renewal in Anne Arundel County to a person,
22 corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage license in any
23 other state, or Washington, D.C.]

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 October 1, 1996.
