16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - State Government**

19 9-101.

20 (g) "Licensed agent" means a person or governmental unit licensed by the
21 Director to act as a State lottery agent.

22 9-117.

23 (a) During a calendar year, a licensed agent [may not] SHALL receive regular
24 commissions that [exceed] ARE 5% of the licensed agent's gross receipts from ticket
25 sales made during that year.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 1996.
