## A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 **Ambulatory Surgical Facilities - Certificate of Need**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of an ambulatory surgical facility that is

- 4 subject to the requirement for obtaining a certificate of need from the Maryland
- 5 Health Resources Planning Commission; eliminating a certain exemption from the
- 6 certificate of need requirement; and generally relating to altering the definition of
- 7 an ambulatory surgical facility that is subject to the requirement for obtaining a
- 8 certificate of need.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### 21 Article - Health - General

22 19-101.

23 (a) In Part I of this subtitle the following words have the meaningsindicated.

24 (b) [(1)] "Ambulatory surgical facility" means any center, service, office, facility, 25 or office of one or more health care practitioners or a group practice, as defined in § 26 1-301 of the Health Occupations Article, that:

27 [(i)] (1) Has [two] THREE or more operating rooms;

28 [(ii)] (2) Operates primarily for the purpose of providing surgical 29 services to patients who do not require overnight hospitalization; and

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1 [(iii)] (3) Seeks reimbursement from payors as an ambulatory surgical 2 facility.

3 [(2) For purposes of this subtitle, the office of one or more health care
4 practitioners or a group practice with two operating rooms may be exempt from the
5 certificate of need requirements under this subtitle if the Commission finds, in its sole
6 discretion, that:

7 (i) A second operating room is necessary to promote the efficiency,8 safety, and quality of the surgical services offered; and

9 (ii) The office meets the criteria for exemption from the certificate of 10 need requirements as an ambulatory surgical facility in accordance with regulations 11 adopted by the Commission.]

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 July 1, 1996.

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
