- 4 attempting to distribute, sell, or rent, certain videos in this State after a certain date
- 5 unless the videos are open- or closed-captioned for deaf and hard-of-hearing
- 6 individuals; providing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act; defining a certain
- 7 term; providing for the applicability of this Act; and generally relating to the
- 8 distribution, sale, and rental of videos.

- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 28 (b) "Video movie" means a videotape or video disc copy of a motion picture film.

4 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "VIDEO" MEANS A RECORDING OF SOUND AND5 IMAGES ON A VIDEOTAPE OR VIDEO DISC.

6 (2) "VIDEO" INCLUDES A VIDEO MOVIE AS DEFINED IN § 14-1601(B) OF 7 THIS SUBTITLE.

8 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO VIDEOS THAT HAVE BEEN GIVEN AN 9 OFFICIAL RATING.

10 (C) AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1997, A PERSON MAY NOT DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR RENT,
11 OR ATTEMPT TO DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR RENT, A VIDEO IN THIS STATE UNLESS THE
12 VIDEO IS OPEN- OR CLOSED-CAPTIONED FOR DEAF AND HARD-OF-HEARING
13 INDIVIDUALS.

(D) ANY PERSON WHO DISTRIBUTES, SELLS, OR RENTS, OR ATTEMPTS TO
DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR RENT, A VIDEO IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE
GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$100 FOR
EACH VIOLATION.

19 [Any] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, ANY person who 20 sells or rents, or attempts to sell or rent, a video movie in violation of this subtitle shall be 21 guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed \$25 for each violation.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 1996.
