1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland - Physician Rehabilitation Program and**
3 **Peer Review Activities - Audit**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the time period within which auditors are required to audit
5 the accounts and transactions of the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland
6 for the physician rehabilitation program and peer review activities.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Health Occupations**

15 14-402.

16 (e) (2) The Legislative Auditor shall [annually] EVERY 2 YEARS audit the
17 accounts and transactions of the Faculty for the physician rehabilitation program and
18 peer review activities as provided in § 2-1215 of the State Government Article.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 1996.
