CHAPTER \_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2           **Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages**  
3           **(Employment of Minors)**

4 FOR the purpose of providing in Carroll County for the employment of minors and other  
5 persons; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Carroll County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 12-302(b)(4) and (c)(3)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13           **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 12-302.

15           (b) In the following jurisdictions the specified exceptions to subsection (a) of this  
16 section apply:

17                   (4) (I) [In] THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH APPLY ONLY IN  
18 Carroll County [the provisions of subsection (c) of this section apply].

19                                   (II) CLASS B LICENSEES MAY EMPLOY A PERSON 15 YEARS OR  
20 OLDER TO PERFORM ANY TASK OTHER THAN THOSE INVOLVING SELLING, SERVING,  
21 OR DELIVERING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

1 (III) A PERSON 18 YEARS OLD AND OLDER MAY SERVE AND SELL  
2 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN RESTAURANTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE SERVING  
3 AND SELLING OF A MEAL.

4 (IV) CLASS A LICENSEES MAY EMPLOY A PERSON 18 YEARS OLD  
5 AND OLDER TO STOCK ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

6 (V) A PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE MAY NOT ACT AS A  
7 BARTENDER OR BARMAID OR IN ANY SOLELY BAR-RELATED CAPACITY.

8 (c) (3) The provisions of this subsection apply[:

9 (i) Within] WITHIN Kent and Queen Anne's Counties[,] to the  
10 holder of any:

11 [1.] (I) Class A (off-sale) license;

12 [2.] (II) Class B (on-sale) license; and

13 [3.] (III) Class C (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license[; and

14 (ii) Within Carroll County, to the holder of any:

15 1. Class A license;

16 2. Class B license;

17 3. Class C license;

18 4. Class D license; and

19 5. Class H license].

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 1996.
