13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	(h) In Carroll County the annual license fee is:
18	(1) \$160 FOR A 6-DAY LICENSE; AND
19	(2) \$1,000 FOR A 7-DAY LICENSE, WITH SUNDAY SALES PERMITTED.

21 22	(A) [In] THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN Carroll County [, notwithstanding any other provisions in this article, the].
23 24	(B) (1) THE following restrictions, limitations, and regulations [shall be in effect] APPLY.
25	[(1)] (2) (I) Holders of "on-sale" licenses authorized under this article
26	may sell, offer for sale, or dispense alcoholic beverages during the hours of 8 a.m. and 1
	a.m. the following day and no other hours. Holders of these licenses may not sell, offer to

28 sell or dispense any alcoholic beverages on Sunday except [that when]:

1 1. WHEN the holder of that license is open for business on 2 Saturday at midnight [he] THE LICENSEE may remain open until 1 a.m. theSunday 3 immediately following; and [except that holders]
2. HOLDERS of Class B, C, and H beer, wine and liquorlicenses 5 AND HOLDERS OF CLASS B BEER AND WINE (7-DAY LICENSES ONLY) LICENSES may 6 reopen and may sell alcoholic beverages on Sundays between the hours of 12 noon and 1 7 a.m. the following Monday.
8 (II) In all cases in which a closing time is indicated in this subsection a 9 licensee may not permit the drinking of any alcoholic beverage on [his]THE premises 15 10 minutes following the closing time indicated.
[(2)] (3) Holders of "off-sale" licenses under this article shall only sell, offer for sale, or dispense the beverages defined in this article between the hours of 8 a.m. and 11 p.m. on Monday through Saturday, and at no other time.
[(3)] (4) A Class 4 manufacturer's licensee may sell wine on Sundays, in a sealed package or container which may not be opened or the contents consumed on the licensee's premises, subject to the other restrictions contained in § 2-205.
17 [(4)] (5) A Class A wine licensee may sell wine on Sundays.
[(5)] (6) The hours established in this subtitle for the sale of alcoholic beverages in Carroll County are hereby declared to be in accordance with Eastern Standard Time when such time is effective and the hours are declared tobe in accordance with daylight time when such time is effective.
