- 4 [TAG ftpo]FOR the purpose of dividing a Class B beer, wine and liquor beer and light wine license
- 5 in Carroll County into a certain number of licenses, at different annual fees;
- 6 specifying when the licensees may be open; clarifying language establishing certain
- 7 restrictions on the hours of operation and the types of sales for a licensee under this
- 8 Act; making stylistic and technical changes; and generally relating to alcoholic
- 9 beverages in Carroll County.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (h) In Carroll County the annual license fee is:
- 20 (1) \$160 FOR A 6-DAY LICENSE; AND
- 21 (2) \$1,000 FOR A 7-DAY LICENSE, WITH SUNDAY SALES PERMITTED.

(II) HOLDERS OF CLASS B BEER AND LIGHT WINE, 7-DAY LICENSES 26 27 MAY CONDUCT "OFF-SALES" OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONLY BETWEEN THE 28 HOURS OF 8 A.M. AND 11 P.M. ON MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, AND AT NO OTHER 29 TIME. 30 [(3)] (4) A Class 4 manufacturer's licensee may sell wine on Sundays, in a 31 sealed package or container which may not be opened or the contents consumed on the 32 licensee's premises, subject to the other restrictions contained in § 2-205. 33 [(4)] (5) A Class A wine licensee may sell wine on Sundays. 34 [(5)] (6) The hours established in this subtitle for the sale of alcoholic 35 beverages in Carroll County are hereby declared to be in accordance with Eastern 36 Standard Time when such time is effective and the hours are declared tobe in accordance with daylight time when such time is effective. 37 38 SECTION 2.
