## SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 18 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 20 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, every new application for a
- 21 license shall be made to the Board of License Commissioners upon forms prescribed by
- 22 the Comptroller and sworn to by the applicant. Every application for a license shall
- 23 contain the following statements:
- (13) (VIII) IN CARROLL COUNTY: 24
- 25 1. THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL:
- 26 A. OBTAIN CRIMINAL RECORDS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
- 27 LICENSE APPLICANTS FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM
- 28 CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND
- 29 CORRECTIONAL SERVICES;

1 B. REQUIRE APPLICANTS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE
--

- 2 LICENSES IN THE COUNTY TO BE FINGERPRINTED; AND
- 3 C. FORWARD THE FINGERPRINTS THROUGH THE CRIMINAL
- 4 JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 5 PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE
- 6 FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY
- 7 RECORDS CHECK; AND
- 8 2. APPLICANTS FOR LICENSE RENEWAL MAY NOT BE
- 9 SUBJECT TO THESE PROVISIONS.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 1996.
