BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 18 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages** 19 10-103. 20 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, every new application for a 21 license shall be made to the Board of License Commissioners upon forms prescribed by 22 the Comptroller and sworn to by the applicant.
