2 **Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Drive-Through Windows)**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Carroll County the sale or dispensing of alcoholic
5 beverages from a "walk-up" or "drive-through" window; and generally relating to
6 alcoholic beverages in Carroll County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 12-207.

16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CARROLL COUNTY.

17 (B) A LICENSEE MAY NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR DISPENSE ANY
18 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM WHAT IS COMMONLY TERMED A WALK-UP OR
19 DRIVE-THROUGH WINDOW.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 1996.
