2 Charter Counties - Vacancies - Special Elections

- FOR the purpose of authorizing a charter county to provide for the conduct of a special election in the event of a vacancy in the county council that occursunder certain circumstances; requiring a local election board to conduct special elections under certain circumstances; authorizing a local election board to development regulations for the conduct of special elections; making this Act contingent on the passage of a certain Constitutional Amendment; and generally relating to the authority of a charter county to hold a special election.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article 25A - Chartered Counties of Maryland 2 5. 3 (Q) 4 (1) To provide for the appointment and removal of all county officers except 5 those whose appointment or election is provided for by the Constitutionor public general 6 law, and to establish a merit system, if deemed desirable, in connection with the 7 appointment of all county officials and employees not elected or appointed under the 8 Constitution and the public general laws; to fix the qualifications andterm of office of 9 such county executive authority as may be established, and to fix its compensation; 10 provided that the county council may enact local laws designed to prevent conflicts 11 between the private interests and public duties of any county officers, including members 12 of the county council, and to govern the conduct and actions of all such county officers in 13 the performance of their public duties, and to provide for penalties, including removal 14 from office, for violation of any such laws or the regulations adopted thereunder. 15 (2) TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONDUCT OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A 16 VACANCY IN THE COUNTY COUNCIL THAT OCCURS UPON THE DEATH OR 17 RESIGNATION OF A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OR ON FORFEITURE OF 18 OFFICE BY A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL. 19 Article 33 - Election Code 20 2-9. (H) IF A COUNTY CHARTER AUTHORIZES THE CONDUCT OF A SPECIAL 21 22 ELECTION TO FILL A VACANCY IN THE COUNTY COUNCIL, THE BOARD: 23 (1) SHALL CONDUCT THE SPECIAL ELECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH 24 THE PROVISIONS OF THE CHARTER; AND (2) MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS AS NECESSARY TO CONDUCT THE 25 26 SPECIAL ELECTION. 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the passage of this Act is 28 contingent on the passage of Chapter _____ (S.B.____/H.B.____) (6lr1926) of the 29 Acts of the General Assembly of 1996, a Constitutional Amendment, and its ratification 30 by the voters of the State.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions

32 of Section 2 above, this Act shall take effect January 1, 1997.
