2 **Natural Resources - New Fishery Management Plans for Certain Varieties of Fish**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to prepare fishery
4 management plans for catfish, king mackerel, Spanish mackerel, tautog, black sea
5 bass, largemouth bass, and smallmouth bass; providing for the effective date of this
6 Act; and generally relating to the preparation of fishery management plans for
7 certain fish.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
