SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

7	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM" MEANS A COURSE THAT OFFERS IN WHICH EDUCATION AND TRAINING IS OFFERED IN THE AREAS OF RECOGNIZING, ADDRESSING, AND RESOLVING ISSUES OF VIOLENCE IN THE HOME AND THE COMMUNITY.
9 10	(B) AT BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY, THERE IS A STATE CENTER FOR <u>ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION AND</u> VIOLENCE PREVENTION.
11	(C) THE CENTER:
	(1) SHALL SERVE AS THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY FOR MATERIALS, DATA, AND INFORMATION RELATED TO VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAMS OPERATING IN THE STATE <u>OR AVAILABLE TO THE STATE</u> ; <del>AND</del>
15 16	(2) MAY OPERATE A VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY THAT IS FREE AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC
17 18	(2) MAY SERVE AS A REFERRAL SOURCE FOR VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OPERATING IN THE STATE OR AVAILABLE TO THE STATE:
19 20	(3) MAY IMPLEMENT VOLUNTEER PREVENTION NETWORKS THROUGHOUT THE STATE;
21 22	(4) MAY PROVIDE RESEARCH AND EVALUATION SERVICES IN THE AREA OF VIOLENCE PREVENTION;
23 24	(5) MAY PROVIDE INFORMATION SERVICES REGARDING VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES;
25 26	(6) MAY PROVIDE OR FACILITATE VIOLENCE PREVENTION EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS;
27 28	(7) MAY PROVIDE MEDIA AND MEDIA-RELATED SERVICES IN THE AREA OF VIOLENCE PREVENTION; AND
29 30	(8) MAY PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL AND ACADEMIC SUPPORT TO DISRUPTIVE YOUTH.
31 32	(D) AN INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP OPERATING A VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM IN THE STATE SHALL BE ENCOURAGED TO SUBMIT TO THE CENTER:
33	(1) A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAM; AND

- 1 (E) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP MAY SUBMIT A REQUEST TO THE
- 2 CENTER FOR INFORMATION ON ANY VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM
- 3 OPERATING IN THE STATE OR AVAILABLE TO THE STATE.
- 4 (2) ON REQUEST, THE CENTER SHALL DISTRIBUTE INFORMATION
- 5 RELATING TO A VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM WITH REASONABLE
- 6 PROMPTNESS.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the
- 8 General Assembly that State general funds may not be used to establish or operate the
- 9 State Center for <u>Alternative Dispute Resolution and</u> Violence Preventionor a violence
- 10 prevention program at Bowie State University.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 1996.
