## 2 Mammography Testing

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting mammography testing unless the center where the testing
- 4 occurs has attained a certificate of approval from the federal Food and Drug
- 5 Administration as specified in a certain federal law; defining certain terms; and
- 6 generally relating to mammography testing.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Article - Health - General

- 16 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 17 (2) (i) "Center" means any facility that [performs mammography
- 18 testing] PRODUCES, DEVELOPS, OR INTERPRETS:
- 19 1. SCREENING;
- 20 2. DIAGNOSTIC MAMMOGRAMS; OR
- 21 3. BOTH.
- 22 (ii) "Center" includes [any unit within a hospital, medical laboratory,
- 23 office of a health care provider, or medical test unit where mammography testing is
- 24 performed] A HOSPITAL, OUTPATIENT DEPARTMENT, MEDICAL LABORATORY,
- 25 CLINIC, RADIOLOGY PRACTICE, OFFICE OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, OR OTHER
- 26 TESTING FACILITY CONDUCTING MAMMOGRAPHY TESTING.
- 27 (III) "CENTER" DOES NOT INCLUDE A FACILITY OF THE FEDERAL
- 28 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

1 2	(3) "MAMMOGRAM" MEANS A RADIOGRAPHIC IMAGE PRODUCED THROUGH MAMMOGRAPHY.
3	[(3)] (4) (i) "Mammography testing" means the imaging of the breast with ionizing radiation.
5	(ii) "Mammography testing" includes xeromammography.
6 7 1	[(4) "Radiation machine" means any device that is capable of producing radiation.]
8 9	(b) On or after July 1, 1992, a person may not perform mammography testing unless:
10 11	(1) The individual performing mammography testing is qualified under Title 14 of the Health Occupations Article; and
12	(2) The center where the mammography testing is performed[:
13 14	(i) Is accredited or has applied for accreditation under the American College of Radiology Screening Mammography Accreditation Program;
15 16	(ii) Is approved by the Health Care Financing Administration of the United States Department of Health and Human Services; or
19 20 21	(iii) Meets the standards established jointly by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland, the Maryland Hospital Association, and the Maryland Radiology Society] HAS ATTAINED A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FROM THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION AS SPECIFIED IN THE FEDERAL MAMMOGRAPHY QUALITY STANDARDS ACT OF 1992.
23 24	(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the penalty for a violation of this section may not exceed \$1,000.
25 26	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
