BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health - General 15 16 20-115. 17 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. 18 (2) (i) "Center" means any facility that [performs mammography 19 testing] PRODUCES, DEVELOPS, OR INTERPRETS: 20 1. SCREENING;

2. DIAGNOSTIC MAMMOGRAMS; OR

4 5	(ii) "Center" includes [any unit within a hospital, medical laboratory, office of a health care provider, or medical test unit where mammography testing is performed] A HOSPITAL, OUTPATIENT DEPARTMENT, MEDICAL LABORATORY, CLINIC, RADIOLOGY PRACTICE, OFFICE OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, OR OTHER TESTING FACILITY CONDUCTING MAMMOGRAPHY TESTING.

16 17	(b) On or after July 1, 1992, a person may not perform mammography testing unless:
18 19	(1) The individual performing mammography testing is qualified under Title 14 of the Health Occupations Article; and
20	(2) The center where the mammography testing is performed:
21 22	(i) Is accredited or has applied for accreditation under the American College of Radiology Screening Mammography Accreditation Program; <u>AND</u>
23 24	(ii) $\underline{\Gamma}$ Is approved by the Health Care Financing Administration of the United States Department of Health and Human Services; or
27 28 29	(iii) Meets the standards established jointly by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland, the Maryland Hospital Association, and the Maryland Radiology Society] HAS ATTAINED A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FROM THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION AS SPECIFIED IN THE FEDERAL MAMMOGRAPHY QUALITY STANDARDS ACT OF 1992.
31 32	(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the penalty for a violation of this section may not exceed \$1,000.
33 34	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
