3	FOR the purpose of approving certain projects for the development and improvement of				
4	certain academic facilities for the University of Maryland System; providing that the				
5	intent of the General Assembly is that the amount of academic facilities bonds that				
6 7	may be issued may not exceed a certain amount in Fiscal Year 1998 and all years thereafter; and approving the issuance of bonds by the University of Maryland				
8	System for financing the projects.				
9	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12	the Performing Arts, University of Maryland College Park (Prince George's County) is				
	hereby approved as a project for an academic facility and the University of Maryland				
	System may issue, sell and deliver bonds in the total principal amount of \$23,500,000 for				
15	the purposes of financing and refinancing the cost of the project.
