- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 18 (a) Unless personal service or some other method of notice is expressly required
- 19 in this article or by the Maryland Rules, the first notice required [orpermitted] to be
- 20 given a person is sufficient if deposited as [ restricted delivery mail] ORDINARY MAIL,
- 21 postage prepaid, [return receipt requested,] addressed to the addresseeat the address
- 22 last known to the SENDER [sender, with delivery restricted to the addressee]. AT THE
- 23 EXPENSE OF THE ESTATE, THE ORPHANS' COURT MAY REQUIRE OR THE PERSONAL

- 1 REPRESENTATIVE MAY ELECT TO HAVE THE FIRST NOTICE GIVEN BY RESTRICTED
- 2 DELIVERY MAIL, POSTAGE PREPAID, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED, ADDRESSED TO
- 3 THE ADDRESSEE AT THE ADDRESS LAST KNOWN TO THE SENDER, WITH DELIVERY
- 4 RESTRICTED TO THE ADDRESSEE.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 1996.
