2 Preneed Burial Contracts - Casket Sales - Trust Requirements

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the seller of a preneed burial contract for the sale of a
- 4 casket to deposit the total contract price into a certain trust account in a certain
- 5 manner; authorizing a withdrawal from the trust account only in a certain situation;
- 6 specifying certain circumstances under which the contract is ended and the seller
- 7 shall refund to the buyer all payments and interest; and generally relating to trust
- 8 requirements for preneed burial contracts for casket sales.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 Article - Business Regulation

- 23 (a) A seller shall put in trust the second 50% of the total preneed burial contract
- 24 price as the seller receives payments from the buyer.
- 25 (b) Within 30 days after receipt of the last payment, the seller shall deposit an
- 26 additional amount to make the balance in the trust account equal to 55% of the total
- 27 contract price.
- (c) This section does not apply to:

3	(1) a preneed burial contract under which all preneed goods andpreneed services, other than dates, scrolls, and other additions that representate more than 10% of the total contract price, must be delivered or performed within 120 days after receipt of 50% of the total contract price; [or]
7	(2) money that a seller receives for preneed goods or preneed services to be delivered or performed within 120 days after receipt of any payment on account of the sale, if the buyer's obligation for these preneed goods or preneed services is separately itemized; OR
9 10	(3) A PRENEED BURIAL CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF A CASKET DESCRIBED IN \S 5-405.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
11	5-405.1.
	(A) A SELLER OF A PRENEED BURIAL CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF A CASKET SHALL DEPOSIT THE TOTAL PRENEED BURIAL CONTRACT PRICE INTO A TRUST ACCOUNT:
15	(1) AS THE SELLER RECEIVES PAYMENTS FROM THE BUYER; AND
16	(2) WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING A PAYMENT.
	(B) A SELLER MAY NOT WITHDRAW FROM THE TRUST ACCOUNT ANY MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE BUYER UNLESS THE MERCHANDISE HAS BEEN PHYSICALLY PROVIDED TO THE BENEFICIARY AS AGREED IN THE PRENEED BURIAL CONTRACT.
20 21	(C) A PRENEED BURIAL CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF A CASKET IS ENDED AND THE SELLER SHALL REFUND TO THE BUYER ALL PAYMENTS AND INTEREST IF:
22 23	(1) THE BUYER OR LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BUYER DEMANDS IN WRITING A REFUND OF ALL PAYMENTS MADE;
24	(2) THE BUSINESS OF THE SELLER IS DISCONTINUED OR SOLD;
25 26	(3) THE SELLER IS UNABLE TO PERFORM UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PRENEED BURIAL CONTRACT; OR
	(4) THE BUYER FAILS TO PAY THE ENTIRE CONTRACT PRICE BEFORE THE DEATH OF THE BENEFICIARY AND THE SELLER CONSIDERS THE PRENEED BURIAL CONTRACT VOID.
30 31	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
