- 4 warnings for amusement attractions is essential to prevent injuries; providing that a

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (a) The General Assembly finds that:
- 20 (1) an unsafe amusement attraction is likely to cause serious and
- 21 preventable injuries to members of the public; [and]
- 22 (2) for the welfare of the people of the State, these injuries must be
- 23 prevented and the public must be protected from unsafe amusement attractions; AND
- 24 (3) COMPLIANCE BY THE PUBLIC WITH SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS AND
- 25 WARNINGS FROM OPERATORS OF AMUSEMENT ATTRACTIONS IS ESSENTIAL TO
- 26 PREVENTING THESE INJURIES.
- 27 (b) The purpose of this title is to ensure, as far as possible, the safety of the public
- 28 in the use of amusement attractions at carnivals, fairs, and amusement parks in the State
