- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of Natural Resources or alocal
- 4 government from requiring a landowner to file a certain declaration of intent stating
- 5 that a proposed activity is exempt from certain requirements regarding forest
- 6 conservation and that the proposed activity does not circumvent certain
- 7 requirements regarding forest conservation; prohibiting the Department or a local
- 8 government from enforcing a declaration of intent filed before the effective date of
- 9 this Act; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to
- prohibiting the Department or a local government from requiring a certain
- landowner from filing a declaration of intent.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (C) THE DEPARTMENT OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT HAS DEVELOPED A
- 22 FOREST CONSERVATION PROGRAM UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT REQUIRE A
- 23 LANDOWNER TO FILE A DECLARATION OF INTENT CERTIFYING THAT A PROPOSED
- 24 ACTIVITY:
- 25 (1) IS EXEMPT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE OR § 5-103 OF THIS TITLE; AND
- 26 (2) DOES NOT CIRCUMVENT THIS SUBTITLE OR  $\S$  5-103 OF THIS TITLE .
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of
- 28 Natural Resources or a local authority may not take any enforcement action against any
- 29 landowner who acts in violation of any declaration of intent filed by the landowner under
- 30 the Forest Conservation Act of 1991 before the effective date of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 June 1, 1996.
