- 41 FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
- 42 BALTIMORE OR FUNDS RECEIVED FROM PRIVATE SOURCES,

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## 12 Chapter 183 of the Acts of 1995

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
- 15 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 16 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 17 Children's Museum Loan of 1995 in a total principal amount equal to thelesser of (i)
- 18 \$1,000,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section
- 19 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 20 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 21 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 22 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 23 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan maybe sold as a
- 24 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 25 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 26 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 27 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 28 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 29 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 30 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects'and engineers' fees:
- 31 as a grant to the Baltimore Children's Museum, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as
- 32 "the grantee") for the acquisition of real property and for the planning, design,
- 33 construction, alteration, AND renovation OF, [and equipping of] FOR THEPROVISION
- 34 OF EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS FOR, AND FOR THE INSTALLATION OF EXHIBITS
- 35 AT RENOVATION, FURNISHING, AND EQUIPPING OF the Baltimore Children's Museum,
- 36 TO BE LOCATED AT MARKET PLACE IN BALTIMORE CITY, ADJACENT TO AND
- 37 INCLUDING AN EXISTING OPEN-AIR PLAZA, THE GRANT TO INCLUDE INCLUDING
- 38 EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE GRANTEE FOR:
- 39 (A) THE PREPARATION OF A MASTER PLAN FOR THE AREA
- 40 IMMEDIATELY SURROUNDING AND RELATED TO THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM;
- 41 (B) THE SECURING OF THIRD PARTY CONSTRUCTION<del>,</del> AND
- 42 DEVELOPMENT, AND MANAGEMENT OF SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE

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1	(C) THE PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, AND PURCHASE OF EXHIBITS FURNISHINGS, FIXTURES, AND CAPITAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE CHILDREN'S
	MUSEUM.
6	(4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bondsas and when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of issuance of the bonds.
8	(5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
9	purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
	fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or
11	indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of
	the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to
13	the effective date of this Act. OR IN KIND CONTRIBUTIONS. THE FUND MAY CONSIST
14	OF FUNDS EXPENDED PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT. THE MATCHING
15	FUND MAY INCLUDE GRANT FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE MAYOR AND CITY
16	COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE OR FUNDS RECEIVED FROM PRIVATE SOURCES, ALL OF
17	WHICH THE GRANTEE HAS EXPENDED FOR USES PERMITTED UNDER THIS ACT OR
	FOR OTHER COSTS AND EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE GRANTEE IN THE PLANNING,
	DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, RENOVATION, FURNISHING, AND
	EQUIPPING OF THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM AND IN THE PLANNING, DESIGN,
	ACQUISITION, FABRICATION, AND INSTALLATION OF EXHIBITS TO BE DISPLAYED IN
	THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund
	or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall
	determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee hasuntil June 1,
	1997, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund
	will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
	equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
	this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified
	by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
