- 9 secondary violation; providing that a violation of this Act is a moving violation for
- the purpose of awarding points against a driver's license; and generally relating to a
- restriction on the original driver's license of a minor.

- 29 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 16-113(h) and (i), respectively of Article Transportation
- 30 of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 16-113(i) and (j),

1 2	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
3	Article - Transportation

	(a) In addition to the vision and other restrictions provided for inthis subtitle, when it issues a driver's license, the Administration for good cause may impose on the licensee:
	(1) Any restrictions suitable to the licensee's driving abilitywith respect to the type of special mechanical control devices required on motor vehicles that the licensee may drive; and
11 12	(2) An alcohol restriction which prohibits the licensee from driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle while having alcohol in the licensee's blood; and
13 14	(3) Any other restrictions applicable to the licensee that the Administration determines appropriate to assure the safe driving of a motor vehicle bythe licensee.
17	(H) (1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II)2 OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL IMPOSE ON EACH LICENSEE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS A RESTRICTION THAT PROHIBITS THE LICENSEE FROM DRIVING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A PASSENGER UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS.
19 20	(II) THE RESTRICTION IMPOSED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH:
21 22	1. SHALL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE THE LICENSE IS ORIGINALLY ISSUED UNTIL THE 181ST DAY AFTER THE LICENSE WAS ISSUED; AND
	2. DOES NOT APPLY TO A PASSENGER WHO IS A SPOUSE, DAUGHTER, SON, STEPDAUGHTER, STEPSON, SISTER, BROTHER, STEPSISTER, OR STEPBROTHER OF THE LICENSEE.
	(2) A POLICE OFFICER MAY ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION ONLY AS A SECONDARY ACTION WHEN THE POLICE OFFICER DETAINS A DRIVER FOR A SUSPECTED VIOLATION OF ANOTHER PROVISION OF THE CODE.
29 30	(3) A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION IS A MOVING VIOLATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF \S 16-402 OF THIS TITLE.
31 32	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
