- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (a) (1) For each fiscal year, the Comptroller shall distribute to a county the
- 21 amount determined for each county under this section.
- 22 (b) (2) If the per capita yield of the county income tax for a county determined
- 23 under paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection is less than [70%] 75% of theper capita
- 24 statewide yield of the county income tax determined under paragraph (1)(ii) of this
- 25 subsection, the Comptroller shall determine the amount that would increase the county

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- 1 per capita yield to equal [70%] 75% of the statewide per capita yield, as rounded to the 2 nearest dollar.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 July 1, 1996.
