- 1 A Senate Joint Resolution concerning
- 2 Abortion Declaration of Human Rights
- 3 FOR the purpose of declaring that an abortion performed solely as a means of birth
- 4 control is unacceptable; and declaring that human rights transcend special interests.
- 5 WHEREAS, A living human fetus, within the womb, is a bearer of humanrights;

- WHEREAS, It is written in the Declaration of Independence that, "We hold these
- 8 truths to be self-evident, that all men are created [not born] equal, that they are endowed
- 9 by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and
- 10 the pursuit of Happiness."; now, therefore, be it
- 11 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the
- 12 General Assembly of Maryland hereby declares that an abortion performedsolely as a
- 13 means of birth control is unacceptable; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That human rights transcend all other special interests; and be it
