## **Guardianship - Minors - Notice**

This bill requires a petitioner for guardianship, when there has been a juvenile proceeding in which the child has been adjudicated to be in need of assistance, neglected, or abused, to give notice of the filing for guardianship to the attorney who represented the child in the juvenile proceeding. Current law requires notice only to the attorney who represented a natural parent in the juvenile proceeding.
