FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 40 (Delegate Conroy, et al.) Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Marietta Mansion (\$750,000)

This bill provides \$750,000 in State bond revenues as a grant to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) for the renovation of the interior of the Marietta Mansion in Prince George's County, including making any necessary constructive changes for the mansion to meet standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The M-NCPPC must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998, and must grant a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$750,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.

Local Effect: Maryland-National Park and Planning Commission revenues would increase by \$750,000 and expenditures would increase by at least \$1,500,000.
