House Bill 80 (Delegate Conroy, et al.)
Commerce and Government Matters

Vehicle Laws - Individuals with Disabilities - Parking

This bill provides that a person may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle on a passenger loading zone designed or marked for the use of individuals with disabilities. The bill also deletes certain sections of law establishing the minimum number of handicapped parking spaces in a parking lot and minimum parking space size. Further, the bill provides that all parking lots constructed after October 1, 1996 must conform to the requirements of the Maryland Accessibility Code adopted under Article 83B, Section 6-102.
