House Bill 120 (Delegate Harrison, et al.)
Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Kennedy-Krieger Children's Hospital
(\$875,000)

This bill provides \$875,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Kennedy-Krieger Children's Hospital for the renovation and expansion of clinical space for the Center for Early Detection and Prevention of Developmental Disabilities in Baltimore City.

The Kennedy-Krieger Children's Hospital must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$875,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
