#### Vehicle Laws - Drunk Driving - Modification of Driver's License Suspension

This bill authorizes the Motor Vehicle Administration to modify a driver's license suspension for drunk driving by allowing a restrictive license for a family's primary caretaker to fulfill the caretaker's responsibilities.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Potential minimal increase in Transportation Trust Fund revenues. No effect on expenditures.

Local Effect: None.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

**State Revenues:** When the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) modifies a suspension, they issue a corrected license. The MVA collects \$20 for each corrected license issued. The total increase in Transportation Trust Fund revenue would depend on the number of suspension modifications issued.
