FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 950 (Delegate Barve, et al.) Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Montgomery County - Foundation for Health Education, Inc. (\$350,000)

This bill provides \$350,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Foundation for Health Education, Inc. for the construction, renovation, and equipping of offices in the Izaak Walton League Building in Rockville.

The board must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998. The funds may consist of in kind contributions or funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$350,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
