FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 1090 (Allegany County Delegation) Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Circuit Court for Allegany County - Courthouse (\$260,000)

This bill provides \$260,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the County Commissioners of Allegany County for the renovation and equipping of the circuit courthouse in Cumberland in Allegany County, including the installation of a security elevator and other security measures.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$260,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.

Local Effect: Allegany County revenues and expenditures would increase by \$260,000.
