## **County Board Plans for Special Education**

This departmental bill repeals the requirement that local boards of education develop plans for the provision of services to children with disabilities.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1996.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** None. Local boards are already required to develop similar plans as a condition of receiving federal funds. Accordingly, eliminating duplicative reporting requirements would not impact local finances.
