County Board Plans for Special Education

This departmental bill repeals the requirement that local boards of education develop plans for the provision of services to children with disabilities.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Local boards are already required to develop similar plans as a condition of receiving federal funds. Accordingly, eliminating duplicative reporting requirements would not impact local finances.

Small Business Effect: The Department of Education has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment.
