#### **State Board of Cosmetologists - Continuation**

This enrolled bill extends the sunset date for provisions of the Business Regulation Article related to the State Board of Cosmetologists from July 1, 1996 to July 1, 1998. The effective date of the bill is July 1, 1996.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** State finances for the State Board of Cosmetologists in the Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing would continue in FY 1997, as discussed below.

**Local Effect:** None.

# **Fiscal Analysis**

**State Revenues:** State revenues will be maintained because the bill proposes to continue the State Board of Cosmetologists. The fiscal 1997 budget includes \$380,000 in general fund revenues for this board.

**State Expenditures:** State expenditures will be maintained because the bill proposes to continue the State Board of Cosmetologists. The fiscal 1997 budget includes \$281,914 in general fund expenditures for this board. Out-year expenditures are expected to remain relatively constant.
