Senate Bill 620 (Senator Sfikas) Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Chase Brexton Health Services, Inc. (\$100,000)

This bill provides \$100,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of Chase Brexton Health Services, Inc. for the renovation of the Chase-Brexton Clinic, a health services facility in Baltimore City.

The board must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$100,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
